Vascular Science Degree January 2023 Update

The new Vascular Science Undergraduate degree is now open to recruitment for its first intake Sept 2023!

This new role will be able to support your service by performing AAA and peripheral aneurysm scans, ABPI/TBI measurements, DVT scans and carotid screening scans to detect the presence/absence of disease

The Vascular Practitioner will not only help increase the workforce and create a complete career framework from level 3 to level 8 helping retain staff but will also standardise the learning and training expected at this level. This is particularly important now that some centres have already developed this role locally to help resolve workforce issues. With an increased workforce it will allow the current band 7 staff time to develop their own roles and create more Consultant Vascular Scientist roles within the Vascular Science profession.
